Subject: Alternate routes to and from ALC

From I-95: Take 198-West in the direction of Burtonsville. Go through two traffic lights. Make a right turn onto Riding Stable Rd. Continue on Riding Stable Rd. to Jerald Rd. Make a right on Jerald Rd. and continue down to Straughn Drive. Make a left turn onto Straughn Drive.

The easiest way to get here from Rt. 198 is off Riding Stable Rd. However, during inclement weather the easiest and safest, especially for those who would make a left turn going back in the direction of I-95 there are a couple of options:

Option 1:

In exiting the subdivision, you can make a right turn onto Riding Stable Rd. Riding Stable Rd. becomes Brooklyn Bridge Rd. and you can take this route (approx. 1 mile) to Bond Mill Rd. At Bond Mill Rd., make a right turn and take it all the way down (approx. 1.5 mile) back to the Rt. 198 intersection.

Option 2:

At the intersection of Straughn Drive and Jerald Rd., you can make a left turn onto Jerald Rd. Take Jerald Rd. to the next corner, which is Kent Rd., and make a right turn. Continue through the stop sign at Parkway Dr and make a left at the next street, which is Windham Rd. Bear right onto Ashland Dr. and follow around to Bond Mill Rd. At Bond Mill Rd., make a right turn and proceed ¼ mile to Rt. 198 intersection.

Notes:

The speed limit in the subdivision is 25 mph. On Riding Stable Rd., it is 30 mph. Please observe.

Riding Stable Rd. becomes Brooklyn Bridge Rd. Brooklyn Bridge crosses over I-95 and goes back into the City of Laurel where it turns into Montgomery Street. You can access Montgomery St. from US Rt. 1.
